Steering group meetings are approximately 1 hour long and we aim to host online webinars approx. 3 times per year - 1.5 hours each time. Please note you will not need to attend every meeting and/or webinar but support with facilitation is appreciated wherever possible.

We are also committed to developing content for the website which will include resources for sharing amongst professionals.

Key aspects of the role include:

- An interest in supporting the development of knowledge and practice in Lewy body dementia, particularly in relation to psychosocial interventions
- Commitment to attending meetings to help plan and deliver resources/ and support webinars (as appropriate)
- Willingness to chair, facilitate and/or present on specific topics relating to Lewy body dementia within webinars where possible.
- Ability to contribute to ideas for future development for the Community of Practice including links with other potential speakers/ contributors
